CHILD FIND is a **FREE** and confidential service provided by professionals at Delta-Schoolcraft ISD (DSISD). Screenings and evaluations through the DSISD help locate as early as possible all children with disabilities who are in need of early intervention and special education services. Child Find activities are coordinated by Early On (birth – age 3) and the Child Find team (ages 3 – 5). Children who may be suspected of having a disability or a delay in one or more of the following areas are offered an appropriate, no-cost program placement if needed:

- ✓Physical Development
- ✓Adaptive Development
- ✓Hearing
- ✓Cognitive Development
- ✓Communication Development
- ✓Vision
- ✓Social and Emotional Development
