

## Eligibility Worksheet

Application and Dues must be submitted between *October 18 and 22.*

CSF advisors will verify your grades to determine eligibility and will make your membership cards available to you when it is feasible to do so.

**To qualify for CSF membership this semester, CAREFULLY follow these guidelines:**

1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
  - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST 1 (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June).
  - b. The first 7 points (including the four points described above must be from LISTS 1 and 2).
  - c. The remaining points may come from LIST 1, 2, or 3.
  
2. **You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify.**
  
3. No CSF points are given for P.E., courses taken in lieu of P.E., subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
  
4. CSF points are granted as follows:  
 Grade of A = 3 CSF points      Grade of B = 1 CSF point  
 One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course-up to a **maximum of two such points** per semester.  
 Grade of C = 0 CSF points  
 Any grade of D or F **disqualifies** you from membership for the semester.

**Also remember:**

1. Semester membership is based on work done in the **previous** semester.
2. You must reapply each semester.
3. Courses you may use are in LIST 1, LIST 2, and LIST 3 on the reverse side of this application.
4. CSF membership will be denied for violations to the Academic Code of Conduct (refer to the Student Handbook).
