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# 10th Annual 5K Run/Walk for Education

Saturday, September 18, 2021 - **This event is open to the public.**

**Proceeds will benefit grants for teachers in District #117.**

Time: 5K Race will start at 8:00 A.M. A free .5K Fun Run (10 & under) will immediately follow the completion of the 5K.

Location: The Square, downtown Jacksonville.

Entry Fees: Registration fee \$23 for adults & \$17 for youth 17 & under. **Only registrations received by September 8th will be guaranteed a race shirt. Limited sizes will be available after this date.**

Make checks payable and mail to: Jacksonville Public Schools Foundation, 211 W. State, Jacksonville, IL 62650. All ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.

**Awards:** Awards for the 5K will be given to the overall male and female winners & the top 2 male and female finishers for each age group (13 & under, 14-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59 and Masters Division). All .5K Fun Run participants will receive a participation ribbon & gift bag.

**Packet Pick-up:** Friday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, at the Foundation office (211 W. State St) from 10a.m. to 2p.m. or at the Jacksonville Square on race day starting at 7 A.M.

**Race Route:** The course begins on the revitalized Jacksonville downtown square exiting south on Main St under the arch heading west on to College Avenue. During your time on College Avenue, you will run by the Jacksonville Public Library, the David Strawn Art Gallery, the notable Jacksonville High School Bowl, and then past the impressive campus of Illinois College. As you turn on to Webster Ave by the Illinois School for the Deaf, the course will take you by Duncan Park and lead you down to Lafayette Avenue where you will head east for one block before turning south on to Sandusky (here you will find **water**). This will bring you back by Duncan Park which is home to Governor Duncan's Mansion. After turning east off of Sandusky on to State Street, you are in the home stretch as you head back to the Downtown Square while passing some of the most beautiful and historic homes in Morgan County.
