

Important foodservice information for incoming 6th and 7th grade families

6th grade families: The milk break program is only a K-5 program in the state of Wisconsin. Therefore if your 6th grader would like to purchase milk at the designated break time it is a \$0.35 per carton ala carte charge (or \$0.30 for juice). This is regardless of free or reduced status. They will be denied this purchase if they have a negative balance or have an ala carte block on their account. Milk that comes with breakfast or lunch is still served and included with the meal if they take hot lunch/school breakfast.

7th grade families: In the secondary building there are a lot of opportunities for extra and ala carte purchasing. The items are designated with a price on them to distinguish which is part of the lunch program and ala carte program. The lunch staff will also answer any questions your child may have regarding this. These things may add up quickly so if you would like an ala carte block on their account let me know before the school year starts. Additionally they are still required to take the correct portion of fresh fruits and vegetables that make up a lunch. If they do not they are charged at the ala carte price for the individual items they take regardless of their free or reduced status. Myself and my staff are there to remind them at checkout, and assist them in going back to put it on their trays the first two or three weeks of the year. After that they are on their own.
