WHEN? April 8-14, 2020 (over Easter)

WHO? This is a trip for all OCDSB students in grades 9-12 who are interested in a geography / Earth science

focused trip. Mr. R. Barter (A.Y. Jackson S.S.), Ms. Souannhaphanh (Glebe C.I.) & Mr. Coates (Earl of March S.S.) will be the trip supervisors.

WHAT? Highlights include:

- Soak in the Blue Lagoon hot spring
- Hike in Thingvellir National Park (see where the continental plates meet)
- Visit the Gullfoss & Skogarfoss Waterfalls
- Visit the Geysir geothermal lands
- See the midnight sun and, if we are lucky, the northern lights
- Climb on a glacier in the Thorsmork Glacier Valley
- Investigate Iceland's active volcanoes
- Explore the black sand beaches of Vik
- Visit a farm and see Icelandic horses
- Walk in historic Reykjavik
- Hike in the Reykjadalur Valley
- Walk under the Earth in the Raufarhólshellir Lava Tunnel (also visit the Lava Centre)



HOW MUCH? The trip will cost \$3900 which covers everything (flights, hotels, gratuities, full travel and health insurance, meals) except your spending money (souvenirs, snacks) and some lunches.
