

Committees

Committees of the Edmonds School District Board of Directors may be created by a majority of the Board. No more than two board members will serve on any board appointed committee. The board president will appoint board members to serve on such committees, the purpose and terms of which will be determined by a majority vote of the board.

Board Committees

It is the policy of the Edmonds School District that no standing committees of the board except a committee of the whole shall be authorized, but special temporary committees may be appointed by the president or chosen by vote of the Board of Directors. The function of special committees shall be fact-finding, deliberative and advisory, but never legislative or administrative. The superintendent or his/her appointed representatives shall be eligible for membership on such committees.

The Board as a whole shall constitute an auditing committee.

Advisory Committees to the Board

It is the policy of Edmonds School District that the Board of Directors may appoint advisory committees and task forces to help solve school problems. All such committees shall be appointed by the Board by action in an official meeting. A committee shall be commissioned for specific purposes and for designated periods which have been identified in writing by the Board.

The function of an advisory committee shall be to give advice and make recommendations to the Board. The Board reserves the right to accept, reject, or return reports to a committee for further deliberation.
