

# Ponca City Public Schools Safety Protocols: 2021-2022

*Updated by BOE Approval on 1.10.2022*

If student or staff percentages of absences are high due to COVID, there could be an intermittent closure at any site with Distance Learning provided. The Superintendent can make the determination to transition a class to Distance Learning if percentages of COVID absences are high or if COVID spread is evident.
